How does the federal budget proposal affect Cabarrus Meals on Wheels?

We receive just over \$70,000 a year from the Older American's Act Funding. Fortunately, we do not rely solely on Federal Funding for our program. But, any reduction in funding will hurt our seniors.

Cabarrus Meals on Wheels assists 400 seniors in their homes with our meal delivery.

90% of our seniors state they need our meals to remain in their homes. Without our service they would need to make other living arrangements.

Many of our seniors live on less than \$800 per month and are unsure where their next meal will come from.

65% stated that they could not afford to eat a balanced meal.

22% stated that they had to go hungry in the last year for lack of funds for food.

33% stated that the food they purchased did not last & they lacked funds for more.

These statistics are unacceptable. In our country, no one should have to go hungry. We are here to help those who need an extra hand. With the proposed budget cuts these percentages will only get worse.

Our program provides the basic need of food, but also the basic need of humanity to our participants. It is hard to put a price on basic humanity to show the true value, but we know that everyday we make a difference to those we serve.

We thank you for your dedication, service, your donations, and, most of all, your time given to help those who need a smile and a meal. Thank you for your continued support of **Cabarrus Meals on Wheels**. We are extremely grateful for everything you do for our participants.


