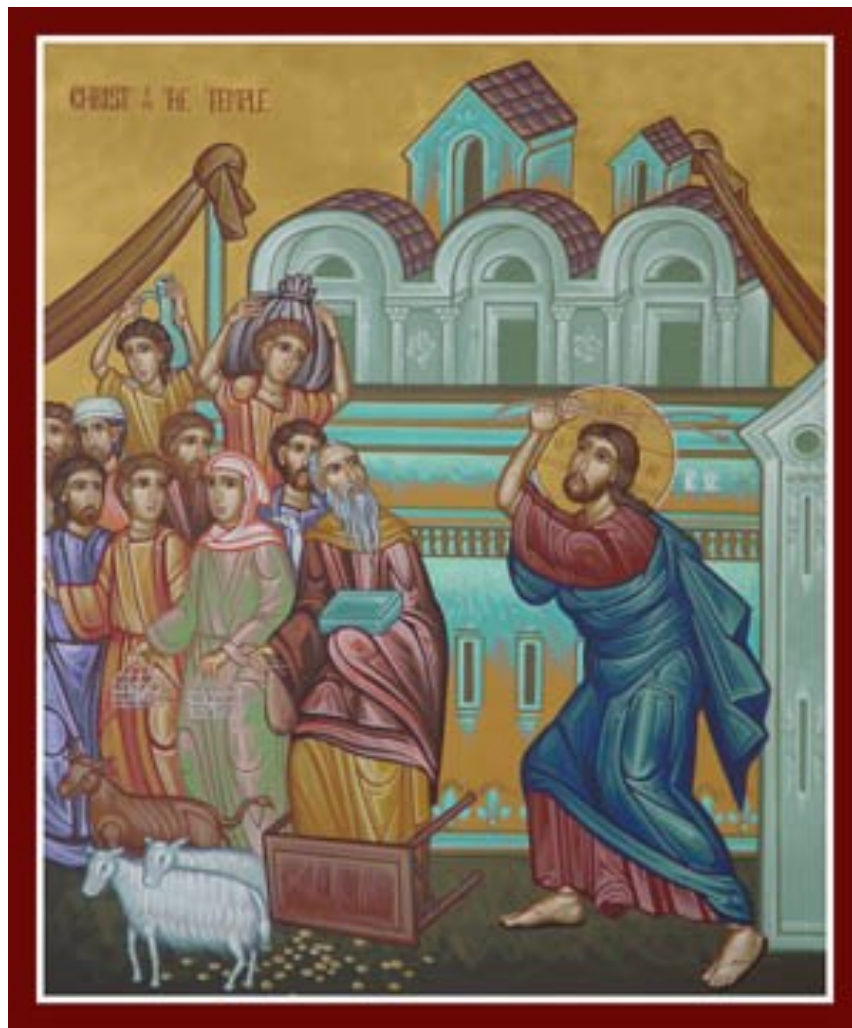

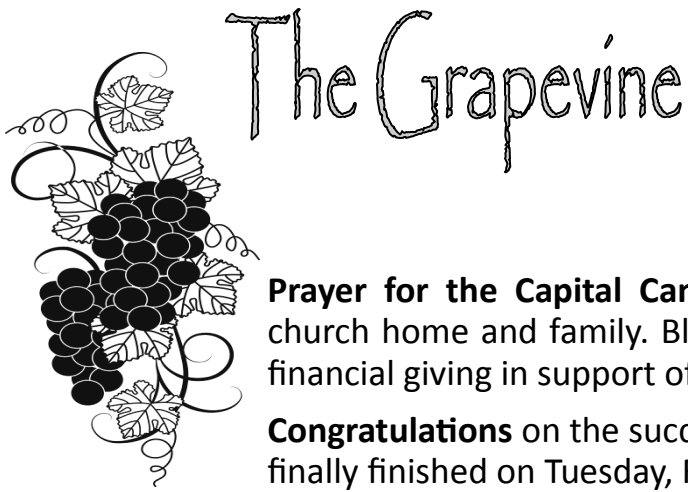
I Love My City
