





ALL SAINTS YOUTH ARE ENCOURAGED TO JOIN THE ACOLYTE MINISTRY

All Saints is blessed to have 18 youth who serve as acolytes during our worship services, but we would like to grow that number! Youth interested in becoming acolytes are invited to a training session for both new and current acolytes (and parents) between Sunday services, August 12th, 10 AM in the Nave.

SCHOOL / COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP WITH FOREST PARK ELEMENTARY



Forest Park is a K - 5, Title I school on the corner of Little Texas Road and Forest Park Drive in Kannapolis. They have 550 students in 26 classrooms projected for the 2018-19 school year. Including the administration, specialists and enrichment teachers, there are about 40 licensed staff members with an additional 25 support personnel working in the office, cafeteria and maintenance department.

All Saints' has committed to an exciting partnership with these professionals to educate their 550 students. For our part, we will provide a little extra support and encouragement for the teachers and staff so that they will have the resources they need. In our first conversation with Mr. Sain, we discovered that their most pressing need is **copy paper**! (Of course, they will use all the notebook paper, hand sanitizer and tissue that they get, too!) We will be collecting money and supplies and are getting on the school's calendar for a back-to-school staff luncheon. The first day for teachers is **August 20th**, students start the next Monday, **August 27th**.

TOUR DE SAINTS - SATURDAY, AUGUST 25TH

The Tour de Saints charity bike ride, scheduled for Saturday August 25th, is an annual outreach event, now in its sixth year. This event, hosted by All Saints' Episcopal Church, is in support of Cooperative Christian Ministries of Cabarrus County.

Our objectives are to raise awareness about the work CCM does in our community, collect non-perishable food items the day of the ride, and generate funds to directly support CCM. For more information about Cooperative Christian Ministry, visit www.cooperativeministry.com.

The ride will begin and end at All Saints' Episcopal Church on Lake Concord Road. The Concord Police Department helps get our cyclists safely out of town and on to less traveled country roads, and the Cabarrus County Sheriff's Department takes it from there.

Routes are available for all ability levels. The 50k, 100k and 50-mile routes traverse scenic rural areas of Cabarrus and Rowan County on classic "Back Country Roads." A 12-mile Family Route is also scheduled. Riders participating in the event will pay an entry fee and donate non-perishable food items. We will provide lunch to the participants and sell lunch to anyone else.

Over the past five years, hundreds of cyclist and volunteers raised over \$40,000 for CCM and collected well over 1,000 pounds of food. We expect good things again this year.
