February | Moving to a plant rich diet

How we eat is a reflection of our moral and religious sensibilities. Using sustainable agriculture methods to grow our fruits and vegetables can actually help increase the carbon and nutrients in the soil and pull excess carbon out of the atmosphere. People who eat a plant-rich/low-meat diet reduce their risks of certain cancers, heart disease, and stroke and have lower healthcare costs.

Election Update | One-stop Early Voting for the Primary starts this week The NC Primary Election is Tuesday, March 3

Regardless of your address, you can vote at your county one-stop. You can also register to vote and vote on the same day (though you cannot change party). Unaffiliated votes may vote in the Democratic, Libertarian, or Republican primaries if desired.

In Cabarrus County, voting will be weekdays, 8:00 AM to 7:30 PM, from Thursday, February 13 through Friday, February 28, plus Saturday, February 29, 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The sole location is the Board of Elections office, 369 Church St. N, Concord. A request for a mail-in absentee ballot is available through Tuesday, February 25.
